



## Wedding Day Itinerary

### **A 3:00 p.m. Wedding Day Sample Itinerary:**

In this sample itinerary it is assumed that the bride lives (or is getting ready) at a location 15 minutes away from the ceremony venue.

<b><u>Time:</u></b>	<b><u>Action:</u></b>
<b>10:30 a.m.</b>	Bride (and bridesmaids) attend their hairdressing appointment
<b>12:00 p.m.</b>	Bride (and bridesmaids) have their makeup done
<b>1:00 p.m.</b>	Bride and bridesmaids have lunch or snack (finger foods)
<b>1:00 p.m.</b>	Flowers are dropped off at the church and final decorating is completed
<b>1:15 p.m.</b>	Photographer arrives at bride's location
<b>1:15 p.m.</b>	Bride and bridesmaids get dressed
<b>1:30 p.m.</b>	Flower girl and ring-bearer arrive at bride's location
<b>1:45 p.m.</b>	Groom and groomsmen get into wedding attire
<b>2:00 p.m.</b>	Officiant, seating ushers and musicians arrive at the ceremony venue
<b>2:15 p.m.</b>	Prelude music is started and the guests begin to arrive
<b>2:20 p.m.</b>	Limousine(s) arrive at bride's location
<b>2:30 p.m.</b>	Groom and groomsmen arrive at the ceremony venue
<b>2:30 p.m.</b>	The videographer arrives at the ceremony venue and sets up
<b>2:35 p.m.</b>	The first cars with mother of the bride, flower girl, ring-bearer and bridesmaids depart for the ceremony venue

<b>2:40 p.m.</b>	The bride and father of the bride depart in their limousine for the ceremony venue
<b>2:50 p.m.</b>	The grandmothers of the bride and groom are escorted down the aisle
<b>2:50 p.m.</b>	The mother of the bride, bridesmaids, flower girl and ring-bearer arrive at the ceremony venue
<b>2:52 p.m.</b>	The mother of the groom is escorted down the aisle
<b>2:55 p.m.</b>	The bride and father of the bride arrive at the ceremony venue
<b>2:57 p.m.</b>	The groom and groomsmen line up at the top of the aisle
<b>2:58 p.m.</b>	The mother of the bride is escorted down the aisle
<b>3:00 p.m.</b>	Processional music begins and the bridal procession begins
<b>3:45 p.m.</b>	The ceremony ends and the recessional begins
<b>3:50 p.m.</b>	The ceremony receiving line is formed
<b>4:00 p.m.</b>	Caterer arrives at the reception location
<b>4:30 p.m.</b>	Photographs are taken at the chosen location
<b>5:30 p.m.</b>	Cocktails and pre-recorded background music commence at the reception location
<b>6:00 p.m.</b>	The reception receiving line with bride, groom and parents is formed
<b>6:30 p.m.</b>	Reception musicians arrive and set up
<b>6:40 p.m.</b>	Presentation to the guests of the bride and groom by emcee
<b>6:45 p.m.</b>	Dinner is served
<b>7:30 p.m.</b>	Toasts and speeches begin
<b>7:45 p.m.</b>	Dessert is served
<b>8:00 p.m.</b>	First dance of bride and groom
<b>8:30 p.m.</b>	Cake cutting ceremony
<b>10:30 p.m.</b>	Bouquet and garter toss
<b>11:00 p.m.</b>	Farewell dance of bride and groom
<b>11:15 p.m.</b>	Departure of bride and groom
<b>12:00 a.m.</b>	Musicians end for the evening
