6 MONTHS OR MORE BEFORE THE GRADUATION PARTY: choose a place and book it (home, outside, restaurant, recreational facility) _choose a date (same day as graduation ceremony, weekday, weekend) choose a time _send save the date cards after you pick a date decide on how long you want the graduation party – 2 hours or all evening _decide on how big of a graduation party; how many guests to invite _decide if you want to combine graduation party with another friend/relative start making an invitation list (you can start with your holiday list) look for pictures to make a photo board and slideshow _start collecting memorabilia (certificates, awards, newspaper clippings) start assembling scrapbooks and photo boards look for songs to add to the graduation slideshow _decide on what type of food contact caterers get house repairs done _decide how much you want to spend; set a budget _decide if you want music or a band

6-8 WEEKS BEFORE THE PARTY:
start purchasing food & beverages, water, pop, liquor, beer
purchase decorations and other supplies
purchase paper plates, plastic silverware, napkins
rent tables, chairs, tents, linens
order invitations
order or make directional cards
make a hotel list for out of town guests
decide who to invite to graduation party and graduation ceremony
finish guest list and addresses
ask a friend to help
pick out music – iPod
order thank you notes
buy stamps
buy return address labels
buy cards and gifts for your graduate and friends
find a place for your pet
finish scrapbooks and photo boards
3-4 WEEKS BEFORE THE PARTY:
mail invitations
if you want an RSVP, include your phone number and email address

order cake
clean house
get lawn ready
find party outfit for you
WEEK OF THE PARTY:
order flowers to pick up the day of
make sure camera is ready; buy extra batteries
shop for last minute supplies
gather crock pots, coolers and supplies to get ready
instruct helpers
pick up food and beverages
wrap gifts for your graduate and friends
confirm delivery of rental equipment
talk to your graduate about your expectations during the party
ask friend if they will take pictures throughout the party so that you can visit
1 DAY PRIOR:
decorate
set up tables for decorations
start getting coolers ready
sweep the front entryway, driveway and garage, if you are using it

DAY OF THE PARTY:
pick up cake
pick up flowers
pick up balloons
get ice
get coolers ready
hang balloons outside
put sign outside
hang banner outside
take your pet to a friend/kennel
set out trash and recycling boxes
set up tables and chairs
give your graduate a big hug and let the celebration begin
take pictures of everyone as they come in the door with the graduate
AFTER THE PARTY:
clean up – have plenty of large trash bags
pay caterer and rentals
send thank you cards within 2 weeks
collect photos and save in photo album for good memories
